#### **CELEBRATION NIGHT**

As stated previously, we are breaking with tradition and have brought Celebration Night forward as a trial for 2017. Given that our school is growing in size, the original plan was to relocate the event to the Banksia Park International High School which we were led to believe has the ability to hold a greater number of guests. 
